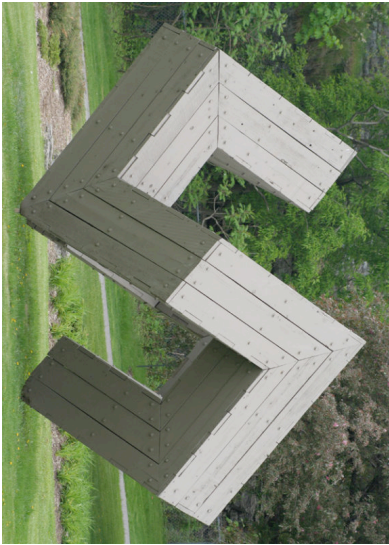


COM1205 Photography - Introduction

“What’s In A Name” Assignment

As a photographer you must learn to see objects in a different way. Change your point of view, look under traditional objects, look up to the roof . . . and you will see things differently. For this assignment you must take photographs of “found” letters (remember that they can not be actual letters from signs or billboards nor can they be created by you such as placing two sticks together to form a letter T).

Take a look at the sample letters “S” and “Q” below.



You will then use these letters to spell your FULL first name. When you have captured these “found” letters, import them from your camera and save them to your student folder. Paste each letter into a Microsoft Word document, save it and place it in the appropriate “Drop Assignments” folder (COM1205 Photography – Introduction). Include your name in the “file name”.
