SCHOLARSHIPS/BURSARIES

Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic achievement, participation in school activities, community involvement, financial need, post-secondary/career plans or a combination of the above. **The deadline to apply is Friday, June 16th.**

ALBERT & FLORENCE MILLER AGRICULTURAL SCHOLARSHIP: (\$1000)

This award is available to An R.F. Staples student entering post secondary agricultural studies. Preference will be given to those entering the agricultural/technician/heavy duty technician faculty. Financial need will be considered.

ALBERTA TEACHERS' ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP-- WESTLOCK LOCAL: (2 @ \$1000)

This award is awarded to students from R. F. Staples who are entering a Faculty of Education and/or furthering their education in any post-secondary institution.

ARISTA HAAS SCHOLARSHIP: (\$1000)

This award is awarded to a grade-twelve student furthering their education in any post-secondary institution.

ARTHUR & GRACE BENTLEY FAMILY BURSARY: (\$1000)

Awarded to a grade-twelve student entering any post-secondary institution who presents a minimum average of 80% in their Grade 12 academic courses (the successful applicant must present a 30-level Math and Science course). The student must have also completed all high school courses at R.F. Staples Secondary School.

BIGGEMAN SCHOLARSHIP: (\$200)

Awarded to a grade-twelve student entering any post-secondary institution who qualifies for financial assistance.

BOSTON PIZZA ENTREPRENEURIAL SPIRIT AWARD: (\$1000)

Awarded to a grade-twelve student entering any post-secondary institution with an entrepreneurial focus. The successful applicant should present school and community-minded contributions.

CROPMAXX INC. AGRICULTURAL SCHOLARSHIP: (\$500)

This scholarship is available to a rural R.F. Staples student entering post secondary in agricultural studies, who has shown sincere interest in: agriculture, academics, school and community participation, and shows a positive relationship with others.

DAVE CROSS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (WESTLOCK SEED CLEANING CO-OP LTD: (\$750)

Awarded to students entering post-secondary agricultural studies based on academic achievement, extra-curricular activities or contribution to community and financial need.

EACH ONE TEACH ONE LITERACY SOCIETY BURSARY: (2 @ \$500)

Awarded to students entering post-secondary studies who demonstrates hard work and diligence who has also overcome obstacles along the way. Students must also demonstrate contributions to their community.

ELKS CLUB OF WESTLOCK SCHOLARSHIP: (2 @ \$1000)

Awarded to students entering post-secondary studies based on academic achievement and financial need.

FAWCETT & DISTRICT FIRE PROTECTION AND TRAINING SCHOLARSHIP:
(\$1000)

Awarded to a rural student from R.F. Staples Secondary School or St. Mary School pursuing a career as a first responder or in healthcare. Preference will be given to those who reside within the Pembina North Community School boundaries however all graduates are eligible.

FAWCETT "PACO" AGRICULTURAL SCHOLARSHIP: (\$500)
PACO-Progressive and Coordinating Organization

Awarded to a rural R.F. Staples student entering post secondary agricultural studies, who has shown sincere interest in: agriculture, academics, school and community participation, and shows a positive relationship with others.

JOHN'S JEWELERS/STEPHANIE STERLING ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP:
(\$1000)

Awarded to a female entering a post-secondary engineering program, based on academic achievement.

LENNON BARLOW & KEYES SCHOLARSHIP: (\$1000)

Awarded to a student entering post-secondary studies based on the following criteria:

1. Financial need
2. Contribution and/or participation in extra-curricular and community activities
3. Academic performance

MERIT CONTRACTORS ASSOCIATION AWARD: (\$300)

This is a construction-based award. The recipient of this award must be in the CTS building construction stream and will be selected by the building construction teacher, thus does not require an application.

PEMBINA HILLS' CITIZENSHIP AWARD: (2 @ \$500)

This scholarship is available to an R. F. Staples student entering a post secondary institution or an apprenticeship program. Students must demonstrate at least three (3) of the following criteria:

- Helps/supports others
- Has a positive attitude
- Displays kindness to others
- Works towards goals
- Listens to others
- Is honest
- Has the courage to do what is right
- Respects others
- Shows concern for others
- Is dependable

PIBROCH AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY SCHOLARSHIP: (\$500)

Awarded to a rural R. F. Staples' student beginning post-secondary agriculture studies, who has shown sincere interest in agriculture, academics, and school related and community participation and has positive relationships with others.

R. F. STAPLES STAFF SCHOLARSHIP: (\$500)

Awarded to a student entering post-secondary studies based on academic and extra-curricular achievements.

RAINBOW PASTORAL SCHOLARSHIP: (2 @ \$500)

Awarded to a student entering post-secondary studies based on academic and extra-curricular achievements.

ROLLINGS BURSARY: (\$500)

Awarded to a R. F. Staples female graduate entering the post-secondary study, preferably, but not necessarily, in engineering, pharmacy, or agriculture, whose registration is confirmed by September the year of application. The student must not be a recipient of any other major award (excluding the Rutherford Scholarship) and have the highest marks in at least two science subjects of any other application.

Friesen Viney Stasiuk Scholarship: (\$1000)

Awarded to a student entering post secondary studies in the field of accounting or finance, based on academic achievement and financial need. Other fields of post secondary studies will be considered based upon stated criteria.

TAYLOR & LANE DUCHARME MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (\$750)

Awarded to a student entering post-secondary studies who personifies kindness and compassion while also demonstrating inclusivity and selflessness in their community through volunteerism and/or extracurricular activity.

UNITED NURSES OF ALBERTA LOCAL 73 SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)

Awarded to a graduate in Westlock who has been into a Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program.

Tamarack Valley Energy: (2 @ \$500)

Awarded to the Grade 12 student with the highest grade in Math 30-1 and Physics 30.

WESTLOCK DRAMA SOCIETY (Alan R. Doherty Memorial) SCHOLARSHIP: (\$1000)

Awarded to a student entering post-secondary study in drama or fine arts, with drama taking preference. If there is not an applicant entering studies in drama, then a student entering studies in fine arts will qualify (e.g. music).

WESTLOCK FIRE AND RESCUE SCHOLARSHIP: (\$500)

Awarded to a graduate seeking a career as a medical, fire or rescue first responder. Consideration will also be given to an individual seeking a career in the medical field either as a volunteer or permanent. (Emergency Medical Responder, Nurse, Nurse's Aid, Doctor as examples.)

WESTLOCK NURSES' CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP: (\$500)

Awarded to a student who had been accepted into a Practical Nursing Program or a Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program.

WESTLOCK ROTARY CLUB (Fred Morie Memorial) SCHOLARSHIP: (\$500)

This scholarship is available to a R.F. Staples student pursuing post secondary study with the goal or intent on owning his or her own business (or obtain a self-employed professional standing). This student must demonstrate concern for school, community and people through active involvement in local, regional or national groups. This scholarship is based on volunteer work in the community and financial need.

WESTLOCK ROTARY CLUB (Jean Duteau Memorial) SCHOLARSHIP: (\$500)

Awarded to a student from R.F. Staples School or St. Mary School going onto any facet of the Fine Arts.

The criteria in awarding the scholarship are as follows:

- 1) Senior Grade 12 student must be going on to secondary education
- 2) Candidate must be advancing into any facet of the Fine Arts, example (dancing, music, or drama)
- 3) Candidate must have a positive attitude towards life, community and peers.
- 4) Candidate should have participated in extra-curricular activities in school and community.
- 5) Candidate should have maintained a high academic standing throughout sr. high.

ZENY BLANCHETTE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP: (\$1000)

This scholarship is available to an R. F. Staples student entering a post-secondary institution or an apprenticeship program. In the spirit of this award, students must demonstrate positive contributions to their school community and community at-large through extra-curricular and volunteerism.

RUTHERFORD SCHOLARSHIPS: (up to \$2500)
